INTRODUCTION

A Treasure Hunt based on technology & Harry Potter. Will you see yourself on the hallowed walls of Hogwarts or will you remain in the shadows in the Muggle World? Only one way to find out!

The Wizarding World has been rife with rumors of the return of "He-Who-Shall-Not-Be-Named". The whispers have now reached the doors of Headmaster Dumbledore, and with so many reports of sightings, he summons the Order of the Phoenix.

As a member of the Order, you have been tasked to find the truth in these rumors and find the Dark Lord.



Rules

- You can participate individually or in a team of at most 2 members.
- You can register only once.
- You should use the internet!
- You need not leave the safe confines of your home.
- All other details, further rules and explanation about the event will be disclosed on the spot.
- Points will be awarded based on the tasks and challenges.
- Organizers reserve the right to alter the rules or gameplay without prior notice.
- The submissions/answers will have to be mailed to the organizers to confirm their submissions.
- In case of a tie-breaker, the timestamps of all clues will be used.
- Hints would be available for each riddle. Using them however, would add a time penalty of +2 minutes for each hint used.
- Any violation of rules will lead to disqualification.
- Certification will be provided for winners and participants as well.

Round 1

Participants will receive a riddle (related to Harry Potter or Technology). They will have to answer it and use the Internet to find a webpage, following which you will be redirected to a QnA where you will see different sets of numbers. You have to understand the logic behind the numbers and decode the options so you can answer the questions.

A total of 1 riddle and 3 questions will be given and their answers will have to be found using the internet, some good old common sense and a dash of Pottermania.

Here, you will have the option to use 2 hints. The first hint would be for the riddle, the second hint would be for the logic behind the numbers.

Using any hints would cost you time!



Round 2

This round involves another treasure hunt - an actual one! Participants would be given a set of 5 riddles (based on Harry Potter or Technology) and they have to solve them. The answers which the participants would want to submit, have to be submitted in the form of a picture instead of text.

For e.g.: If the answer to a riddle was "door", then the participants would have to click a real time photograph of a door in their house and submit it to the organizers.

Here you will have the option to receive a hint for each riddle. Using any hints would cost you time!

You can also submit incomplete answers – for eg. If you were able to find answers to only 4 riddles, and don't want to use the hint for the 5th riddle, you can submit just the 4 riddles.



Round 3

Participants will be assigned a character from the Order of the Phoenix and there will be an imposter amongst them. They will have to find the imposter by asking each other questions on a Google Meet. The imposter can choose to pretend to be any character, but will have to answer questions truthfully.

For example, let's assume the imposter is pretending to be Alastair Moody. The questions is asked "When did you attend Hogwarts?". Since, the imposter cannot lie, he has to reply truthfully and suppose he replies "1991" – clearly, the imposter has been caught as Moody was too old to graduate from Hogwarts in 1991.

Participants will get 2 minutes to complete this QnA session, after which there will be a vote on who they think is the imposter.

The person who gets the most votes is eliminated. Participants are then asked if they think they have eliminated the imposter.

- If they reply yes and they have not eliminated the imposter, the imposter wins the round.
- If they reply yes and the imposter has been eliminated, the remaining participants have won the round and will all be ranked based on their previous scores.
- If they reply no, the next round continues and the discussion continues.
